



## Copper Cookie Sheet Care Card

Your House Copper copper cookie sheet is hand-made in Wisconsin. The copper is pure CDA 110 or 122 grade, and is lined with hand-wiped, food-grade tin manufactured in Iowa. For proper care, please follow the instructions listed here:

- Always use wooden or soft silicon utensils
- Avoid metal utensils
- Hand wash only and dry immediately with a soft cloth.
- Do not use over 400F (Do NOT use to Broil!)
- Do not use on the stovetop
- Oven safe
- Do not use steel wool, scouring pads or harsh soaps
- Always have food on the sheet to help absorb heat

You may wish to keep the copper looking shiny and new. If so, use a copper polish or a 2-1 ratio of lemon and salt. If you like, you may also add 1 part vinegar to the mixture for additional shine.

Please note if you use a commercial copper polish to follow the instructions on the labeling. If you use a commercial copper polish, it may not be used on the tin lining.
