



Copper Cup Care Card

Your House Copper copper cup is hand-made in America. The copper is pure CDA 122 grade and is 3mm thick to stave off warping. For proper care, please follow the instructions listed here:

- Avoid using metal utensils.
- Do not fill with hot liquid.
- Hand wash only and dry immediately with a soft cloth.
- Do not use in the oven or broiler or over a stove.
- Do not heat or cook in unlined copper (like this cup).
- Do not use steel wool, scouring pads or harsh soaps.
- Do not use with vinegar-based food or liquid.

Our copper cups, as the copperware of old, will develop a lovely patina with use and time. You may wish to keep the copper looking shiny and new. If so, use a copper polish or a 2-1 ratio of lemon and salt. If you like, you may also add 1 part vinegar to the mixture for additional shine.

Unlined copper cups are best used with neutral pH liquids.

Please note if you use a commercial copper polish to follow the instructions on the labeling.
